The middle one is characteristically pink due to carboxyhaemoglobin; this slice of liver was obtained from a person who died from carbon monoxide poisoning. On the right is a congested or nutmeg liver showing alternate areas; yellow from fatty change, and red from congestion. This is an appearance commonly seen in patients who die from congestive cardiac failure.
